1) Set up a realistic academic plan

- -Some students shouldn't be encouraged to take full-time school
- -Please ask how much time they have to devote to school each week
- -Too many classes deemed difficult or time-consuming could be considered unrealistic
- -An understanding of a realistic timeline to applying to PPA program

2) Learn about the program and how to successfully pursue program plan

- -Special admission requirements
- -Process to apply to program
- -Pre-requisites to program
- -Special entrance exam information

3) Discuss how to be successful within pre-requisites

- -When courses are offered
- -What courses go well together and which courses should be separated
- -Policies and strategies for repeating courses
- -Specific resources available for program type
