Dear Major Advisor:

The Academic Advising Center values your assistance to students who are on probation. As part of the student's hold, they are required to meet with their major advisor to:

1) Set up a realistic academic plan

- Some students shouldn't be encouraged to take full-time school.
- Please ask how much time they have to devote to school each week.
- Too many classes deemed difficult or time-consuming could be considered unrealistic

2) Learn about the major and how to successfully declare a major

- Curriculum overview
- Special admission requirements
- Process to apply to program or declare
- Pre-requisites information

3) Discuss how to be successful within major coursework

- When courses are offered
- What courses *go well together* and which courses *should be separated*
- Strategies for repeating major classes
- Specific major, department, or college resources available
