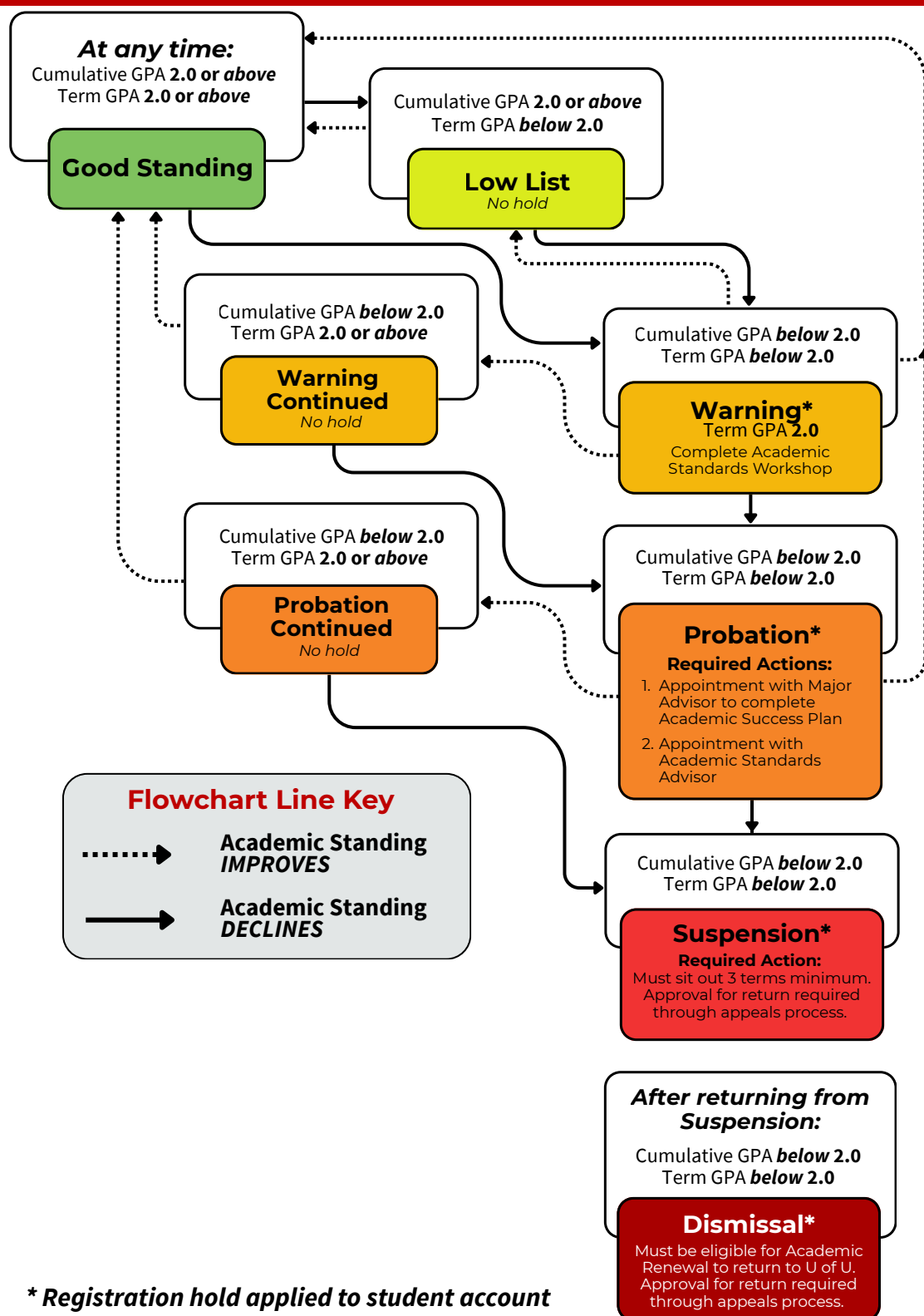


Academic Standards Flowchart



Understanding the Flowchart

Start by identifying your current academic standing. This is determined by your current U of U cumulative (overall) GPA, most recent term (semester) GPA, and your prior academic standing.

From your current standing, follow each of the arrows leading outward to see the different potential outcomes for your next semester, depending on the cumulative and term GPA that you earn.

Dotted line arrows show potential results of making GPA progress, and solid line arrows show potential results of remaining under a 2.0 for future terms.

When a student's U of U **cumulative & term** GPA are **both below 2.0** for the first time, they are placed on **Warning**. Following this, if both cumulative & term GPA **remain below 2.0** for a second term, they move to **Probation** & can face **Suspension** or **Dismissal** after a third consecutive term below 2.0.

Following a Warning or Probation term, a student whose **term GPA increases** to 2.0 or above while their **cumulative GPA remains below 2.0** will be placed on **Warning Continued** or **Probation Continued**.

Once a student's cumulative GPA has **increased to a 2.0 or above**, they return to **Good Standing**.
