### Advisor Tips

Expo can be a bit overwhelming, so it helps to prepare. Reflect on what you'd like to learn--are there specific majors you want information from, or programs like PreMed?

Advisors also want to share that they cannot advise on individual credit or records at an event like this, so large scale questions specific to AP/CE (i.e., how long will it take me to graduate if...) are best for email or future appointments!



### Example Questions:

1. Does this major have any admission requirements?
2. Are there specific Learning Abroad programs, internships, undergraduate research, clubs or other common opportunities for this major or program?
3. What graduate programs or career areas do your students go into?
4. Are there common minors or double majors for students in this area?
5. Is there anything I can do in my last year of high school to prepare for this major?
6. Any fun facts about your major or program?
