













## Plan Builder Icon Key

	<b>View PDF:</b> Generates a PDF file that can be saved or printed. This appears for both the roadmap and the plan.
	<b>Add Roadmap:</b> Adds an additional roadmap to be incorporate in your plan. This is useful for students planning a double major.
	<b>Move All:</b> Moves every course on the roadmap to the corresponding semester on the plan. <b>Proceed with caution! Not recommended for most majors!</b>
	<b>Move Preferred:</b> Similar to Move All, but moves over courses with a marked status and any course where no choice is given in that particular roadmap requirement.
	<b>Audit View:</b> Used to check your plan for completeness. Generates a degree audit report (DARS) for the roadmap you are currently using, incorporating any planned courses.
	<b>Associated Roadmaps:</b> Displays all roadmaps used in creating the plan, and quickly switch back and forth between roadmaps. This is useful for double majors.
	<b>Completed Courses:</b> Displays a summary of all of your completed and in progress courses.
	<b>Check Plan:</b> Checks your plan against a degree audit (DARS). Use this to see if your planned courses meet more than one requirement.
	<b>Remove All:</b> Removes all courses from your plan.
	<b>Add:</b> Adds additional semesters to your plan.
	<b>Edit:</b> Opens the semester for editing. Edits include deleting courses and adjusting credit hours. Editing credit hours should only be used for variable credit courses.
	<b>Delete:</b> Deletes an entire semester, including any planned courses.
